

MESSAGE FROM MR JOHN BYRNE
CONFIRMING CPD CREDITS

There has been some misunderstanding in Hong Kong regarding the CPD hours which may be claimed for attending my forthcoming course.

Some teachers have thought that any non RAD course could only be granted a maximum of 2 hours in CPD credits. **THIS IS INCORRECT.** Credits of 2 hours refer to short term independent activities like attending a ballet performance, reading a ballet text etc. They do NOT refer to non RAD courses which take place over a 2 day period. These courses can be credited up to a maximum of 10 hours. Teachers have been able to claim the actual hours of course delivery, excluding lunch and tea breaks for non RAD courses. However, in the past few days I have received notification from RAD Headquarters in London, that from now on, non RAD courses may also claim the actual hours of course delivery PLUS lunch hour and tea breaks. In other words, RAD courses and non RAD courses attract **EXACTLY THE SAME** number of hours in CPD credits.

I guarantee, on advice from the RAD London, that teachers attending my course in Hong Kong will gain 10 hours of CPD CREDITS, and will receive a **CERTIFICATE** to that effect.
